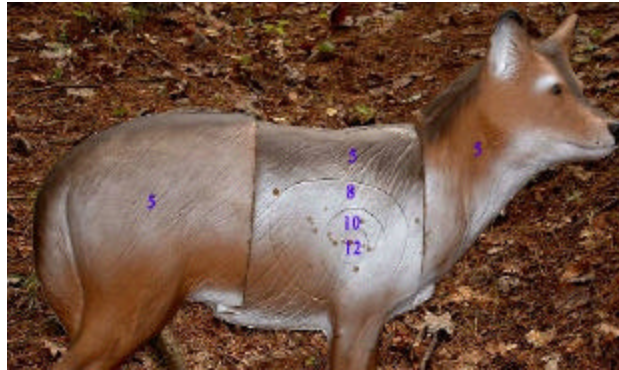

Young Adult 15-17 Youths 12-14 Cubs 8-11 PeeWee 0-7 Senior 55
Youths, Cubs and PeeWee will compete as one style, regardless of equipment
4 Scoring Areas, 12-10-8-5, Touch Line for Higher Score



No Cameras or Range Finders. Binoculars are allowed. Spectators Allowed, but not allowed to discuss distances and give help.

There is a shooting time limit. Trophies awarded @4PM. Maximum distance is 40 yards.

280 feet per second maximum plus 3% No discussion of distance or sight settings.

Adult men, Senior men and Young Adult men shoot from **WHITE STAKES (40yard Max.)**

Youth and Women shoot from **RED STAKES (30 yard Max.)**

Traditional (using long bow or recurve bow and Cubs shoot from **BLUE STAKE (25 yard Max.)**

PeeWee age group is up to and including age 7 shoot from the **GREEN STAKE (15 yard Max.)**

Awards will be **TROPHIES**

Registration \$12 and \$25 per IMMEDIATE family, Cub and Pee Wee \$6.00

Money Division, two divisions, Open and Pins \$12.00, 40% of reg. 1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%

NO UNIT RULE, 1st, 2nd and 3rd places awarded. **Money Division will be listed as Pro or PFS**

Flights will consist of no more than 15 archers plus ties. Committee may make the Flights less.

Styles of Shooting:

- Open with Release (Open/R) (FS NFAA rules)**
- Open with Fingers (Open/F) (FSL NFAA rules)**
- Fixed Pins with Release (P/R) (FBH NFAA rules) (Hunter)**
- Fixed Pins with Fingers (P/F) (FBHL NFAA rules) (Hunter Fingers)**
- Bowhunter and Barebow compound bow (BH or BB) (BH or BB NFAA rules)**
- Traditional, longbow and recurve, no sights or stabilizer (TRAD).**

Awards for Cub and PeeWee will be Medal or Trophy
